WHEREAS, the Judicial Conference of the United States – in 2005 – promulgated Interim Rules and Official Forms (collectively, the “2005 Interim Rules”) to implement the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the “Act”);

WHEREAS, this Court, by means of **General Order M-308** (signed October 11, 2005), adopted the 2005 Interim Rules in their entirety and mandated that such rules were to apply to cases governed by the Act (unless otherwise ordered by the Court);

WHEREAS, new and amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (“2008 Rules Amendments”) are to take effect on December 1, 2008 assuming there is no Congressional action on the 2008 Rules Amendments before such date; and

WHEREAS, the 2008 Rules Amendments, after their effective date, are to supersede the 2005 Interim Rules; it is hereby

ORDERED that General Order M-308 is vacated, effective December 1, 2008.
