WHEREAS, it is currently unclear when the United States Bankruptcy Court in Manhattan will again be accessible,

WHEREAS, current transportation restrictions render it difficult and in some cases impossible for individuals to travel to the Courthouse, it is now

ORDERED that CourtCall shall record all hearings of the Bankruptcy Court of the Southern District of New York from November 5, 2012 until November 30, 2012, unless otherwise instructed not to do so by the Chief Judge or any judge assigned to a particular matter.
