NOW, it is

ORDERED, that the Suggested Interim Bankruptcy Rules of the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Judicial Conference of the United States be and they are hereby adopted effective January 10, 1980, and it is further

ORDERED, that from and after January 10, 1980 in respect of cases and proceedings arising under the 1978 Bankruptcy Code, the Suggested Interim Bankruptcy Rules of the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Judicial Conference of the United States be and they hereby are in effect, and it is further

ORDERED, that the adoption of such Suggested Interim Bankruptcy Rules of the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Judicial Conference of the United States shall in no way prevent the adoption of such further local supplemental rules as to the judges of this court seem appropriate.
