This matter is before the Court upon the application and request by Zihan Ye (the "Applicant") for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts.

The Court finds, based upon the attached letter received on June 18, 2024, that the Applicant has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information.

Accordingly, the Applicant shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court to the extent such use is incurred in connection with the project described in the attached letter and application. The Applicant shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court.

Additionally, the following limitations apply:

- 1. This fee exemption applies only to the Applicant, and is valid only for the purposes stated above.
- 2. This fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
- 3. By accepting this exemption, the Applicant agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption.
- 4. This exemption is valid from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.


In this attachment, I outline the steps for data collection and provide a summary of the distribution of cases from each bankruptcy court.

Data Collection Steps:

- 1. **Locating Cases:** Using the docket number (see the attached Excel file for a complete list of the 1,271 cases), I will locate each bankruptcy case on PACER. I will match on the filing date and search for "health" as a key term in the case title to identify the relevant bankruptcy cases.
- 2. **Case Summary Collection:** After identifying the case, I will click on the Case Summary to collect specific information. This includes the entity name, filing date, termination date, county, judge, attorney, and EIN.
- 3. **Additional Data Collection:** To further understand the process and the parties involved in each case, I will also explore other queries, such as details on the attorney, list of creditors, and notice of bankruptcy case filing party, among other relevant information.

Example of Data Collection:

• For case 07-06704, I entered the case number and selected the jurisdiction type as Bankruptcy. This yielded 12 search results.



- Based on the filing date from the FJC (2007/11/12) and the presence of "HEALTH" in the
 case title, I identified the case as "TOA ALTA COMPREHENSIVE URBAN RURAL
 ADVANCED HEALTH."
- By clicking on the Case Summary under the Query for this case, I gathered the necessary information.
- As the research project progresses, I may need to run additional queries for details such as attorney information, the list of creditors, and notices of bankruptcy case filings.

Summary of Case Distribution: The 1,271 cases are distributed across 62 bankruptcy courts, as detailed below:
